January 12th Earthquake

The January 12th earthquake that shook Haiti for 40 seconds destroyed nearly every program and structure we built over the past 15 years. Doug Campbell and Fr. Tom Hagan barely escaped their Port-au-Prince headquarters as it collapsed, killing 2 Oblate seminarians inside. We lost many students and staff from our 8 schools and our buildings were badly damaged. During the "post-earthquake" months, we worked tirelessly to provide food, water, shelter, & medical aid to thousands who came to us for help. Thanks to the generosity of our supporters we've accomplished a great deal in the short 6 months since the January quake:

- Ongoing daily water truck distributions in slum areas;
- 220 tents to HT staff and families who lost their homes;
- Ongoing mobile clinic to five areas in Cite Soleil providing free medicines and health care;
- 10,000 food kits of rice, beans, oil and canned fish to the elderly & residents of tent cities and Cite Soleil;
- 50 temporary classrooms and made repairs to 4 main campuses and reopening schools on March 3rd – providing 4,000 students with a daily meal and schooling;
- Cleared rubble from fallen residences, constructed new offices and storage depot;
- 300 HT staff with recovery grants to help them with housing and other personal needs;
- 100 construction jobs to people in Cite Soleil;
- 16 water wells drilled in and around P-au-P.

Help us with our Earthquake Recovery & Rebuilding

The recovery from this earthquake will take time and persistence. Already we've saved many lives and helped thousands of families, but there is still a great deal of work that must be done. All proceeds from the Golf Classic will help us complete our recovery plan which includes:

- **Recovery Grants** - to the "Hands Together Universe" - all staff, students and families - essentially 20,000 people. These grants help with housing and basic family needs. Much of Port-au-Prince remains in tents;
- **School Building and Repair** - We need to reinforce all buildings and outfit them with benches, computers, and proper educational materials. We need to purchase books for 6,000 students. We need to build individual kitchens at our three main campus centers and purchase new dishes.
- **Elderly Feeding** - We feed 1,200 elderly per day and provide food kits every few weeks. The elderly rarely receive the food and water that's distributed by large aid organizations.
- **Rebuild Volunteer Headquarters** - After we complete renovations on our school buildings we need to completely rebuild our volunteer complex. It will house our Haitian and American volunteers & staff and safely store our vehicles, equipment and food.
- **Agricultural Development** - Agricultural production and vocational training can help Haiti develop and prevent the overcrowding of Port-au-Prince because people will stay in their villages and work the land if given the training and opportunity. We will expand our efforts at two large farming projects in the northern part of Haiti.
